

Student Subsidies

In order to encourage participation by graduate students in AMES 2012, *ex post* subsidies will be available. The following eligibility criteria and procedure will apply.

Eligibility

- The applicant must be a *bona fide* graduate student, i.e., one currently enrolled as a Ph. D. student.
- The applicant must give a Contributed Talk at AMES 2012.
- While the subsidies may be awarded to *bona fide* graduate students from anywhere, priority will be given to those enrolled at universities within the Asian region covered by AMES 2012.

Nature of subsidy

- The subsidy may be used to offset (a) travel costs (airline or train tickets), (b) accommodation costs, or (c) registration fees.
- The actual amount of the subsidy will be determined and paid by cheque or Bank Transfer after AMES 2012 concludes.

Application procedure

Submit the following at the time of Local Registration:

- The Student Subsidy Application Form available at <http://econdse.org/wp-content/uploads/2012/10/Student-Subsidy.docx>
- Supporting bills/receipts, boarding passes (if applicable).
- A copy of valid student Identification.
- A letter from the Head/Chair of your institution attesting to your *bona fides*.

The above documents should be submitted to Mr. Surjeet Singh (Manager, CDE). He will counter-sign your application form, make a copy and give it to you as your receipt.
