A Word About Supriya Nayak

Supriya Nayak trained in Odissi under Smt. Kiran Segal. Since her debut in 2006, she has been featured extensively within the country at major festivals, including the NCPA and *Nalanda Nrityotsava*, Mumbai; the Orissa Dance Academy, Bhubaneswar; as well as festivals organized by the *Sangeet Natak Akademi*, ICCR and *Sahitya Kala Parishad*. As a senior member of her *guru's* Pallavi repertory, Supriya has performed at the Prithvi Theatre Festival, Khajuraho Festival, Konark Festival, Bharat Bhavan (Bhopal) and the Festival of New Choreographies, Delhi. She has travelled to China, Canada, Bangladesh, Kazakhstan and South Africa as a cultural ambassador. Empanelled with the Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR) and Doordarshan, Supriya's dance has been appreciated for "the lyrical beauty of the pure *nritya*" and her "fresh, subtle and mature *abhinaya*". An Honours graduate from St. Stephen's College, Supriya is now intensively working on dance pedagogy.
