Applications are invited to fill two positions of "Field Worker" for an ongoing SERB sponsored research project entitled "Institutions for Promoting Gender Parity in Indian Labor Market" housed at Delhi University and funded by the SCIENCE & ENGINEERING RESEARCH BOARD (SERB), Department of Science & Technology, Government of India [File number: CRG/2023/007342].

Required Qualification: Batchelor's degree with a CGPA of at least 6 (60%).

Desirable Qualification: data entry and enumeration skills. Knowledge of software such as Excel, STATA, R, Python is preferable.

Duration: The selected candidate will be recruited as Field Worker for a period of **9 months** - starting January 1, 2026. Continuation of the employment is subject to satisfactory performance.

Emolument: A consolidated salary of <u>Rs. 18,000.00 (Eighteen Thousand Only) per month + HRA</u> at the rate of 30%.

(HRA is payable only if the candidate is not availing University accommodation/hostel).

The candidate will not be eligible for any other payments/allowances/benefits.
