


Dr Manmohan Singh Fellowship at the Delhi School of Economics

Terms and Conditions



The following terms and conditions will apply to the Dr. Manmohan Singh Fellowship from the academic year 2025-26:

- (i) The Dr. Manmohan Singh Fellowship was instituted at the Delhi School of Economics (DSE) by the Dr. Manmohan Singh Trust in 1998. From 2025-26 onwards, it will be awarded to the two students who obtain the highest aggregate scores in the M.A. Economics (Part I) examination at the DSE.
- (ii) The Fellowship is for a period of one year, *i.e.*, for the duration of M.A. (Part II). It offers a stipend of Rs. 10,000 per month.
- (iii) The Fellowship will be awarded on the basis of the recommendation of the Scholarship Committee of the Department of Economics. The DSE will enclose a letter of acceptance from the selected Fellows along with its recommendation to the Trust.
- (iv) A student who is awarded the Dr. Manmohan Singh Fellowship should not simultaneously be in receipt of any other scholarship.
- (v) The Trust will disburse the stipend directly to the Fellow in two equal instalments. The first instalment of Rs 60,000 will be paid on receiving the letter of acceptance from the selected Fellow. The second instalment of Rs 60,000 will be paid at the start of the fourth semester. The Fellow will duly acknowledge receipt of each instalment.
- (vi) The Dr. Manmohan Singh Fellowship will be suspended in case a Fellow accepts a scholarship from any other source; fails in the third semester examination; discontinues his/ her studies at the DSE; or if the DSE has reasonable grounds to believe that s/he is guilty of gross misconduct.
