

PRIVACY POLICY

1. Centre For Development Economics and Delhi School of Economics recognizes the importance of maintaining your privacy. We value your privacy and appreciate your trust in us. This Policy describes how we treat user information we collect on www.econdse.org, other online and offline sources.
2. This Privacy Policy applies to current and former visitors to our website and to our online customers. By visiting and/or using our website, you agree to this Privacy Policy.
3. Centre for Development Economics is a part of Delhi School of Economics, having its registered office at Department of Economics, Delhi School of Economics.
4. Information we collect:
 - Contact information: We might collect your name, email, mobile number, phone number, street, city, state, pin code, country and IP address.
 - Information you post: We collect information you post in a public space on our website or on a third-party social media site belonging to Centre for Development Economics.
 - Demographic information: We may collect demographic information about you or any other information provided by you during the use of our website. We might collect this as a part of a survey also.
 - Other information: If you use our website, we may collect information about your IP address and the browser you're using. We might look at what site you came from, duration of time spent on our website, pages accessed or what site you visit when you leave us. We might also collect the type of mobile device you are using, or the version of the operating system your computer or device is running.
 - We collect information in different ways: We collect information directly from you when you fill any online application or request/inquiry forms that we include in our website or social media handles. We also collect information if you post a comment on our websites or ask us a question through phone or email.
 - We collect information from you passively: We use tracking tools like Google Analytics, Google Webmaster, browser cookies and web beacons for collecting information about your usage of our website.
5. Use of your personal information: We use information to contact you. We might use the information you provide to contact you for promotional purposes.
 - We use information to respond to your requests or questions. We might use your information to confirm your application.
 - We use information for security purposes. We may use information to protect our organization, our human resources, or our websites.
 - We use information as otherwise permitted by law.

6. Sharing of information with third-parties: We will share information with third parties who perform any services on our behalf.
 - We may share information if we think we have to in order to comply with the law or to protect ourselves. We will share information to respond to a court order or subpoena. We may also share it if a government agency or investigatory body requests. Or, we might also share information when we are investigating potential fraud.
 - We may share information with any successor to all or part of our business. For example, if part of our service is sold, we may give our information as part of that transaction.
